

# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

NOTICE TO MUNICIPAL ELECTORS OF  
THE CORPORATION OF THE

## TOWNSHIP OF LAURENTIAN VALLEY

TAKE NOTICE that nominations for positions on the 2010 to 2014 Municipal Council may be filed between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. on nomination day, **Friday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010**, or during the period from **Tuesday, January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010 to Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010** inclusive immediately preceding nomination day, at a time when the clerk's office is open.

### OFFICES FOR WHICH PERSONS MAY BE NOMINATED

Mayor (1) one to be elected at large  
COUNCILLOR (6) six to be elected at large

TRUSTEE, Renfrew County (1) one to be elected from the combined area of the  
District School Board Township of Laurentian Valley, and the Township of North  
Algona Wilberforce.

---

TRUSTEE, Renfrew County (1) one to be elected from the combined area of the  
Catholic District School Board Township of Laurentian Valley, Township of  
Admaston/Bromley, Township of North Algona  
Wilberforce, & the Township of Bonnechere Valley.

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that nominations must be filed using the prescribed form (obtainable from the Municipal Office). The nomination form must be signed by the candidate, and may be filed in person or by an agent as set forth in section 33 of the Act. Nominations forms must be accompanied by the prescribed filing fee of \$100.00 for Councillor and School Board Trustee or \$200.00 for Mayor, payable by cash, certified cheque or money order (credit card or debit card payments are not accepted).

Faxed or emailed Nomination Forms are not acceptable and will be rejected.

You are entitled to be an elector and to run for elected office if you are not disqualified by any Act or Law on voting day and if you are:

- A resident of the municipality
- A non-resident who is an owner or tenant of land in the municipality or spouse of or same sex partner of such owner or tenant
- A Canadian Citizen
- 18 years of age or older

Nomination papers must be filed with the Clerk at the municipal office of the Corporation of the Township of Laurentian Valley, 460 Witt Road, PEMBROKE, Ontario. K8A 6W5. Phone (613) 735-6291.

If, after filing a nomination, a candidate wishes to file a nomination for a different office in the same election, the first nomination shall be deemed to have been withdrawn at the time the second nomination is filed. The filing fee paid for the first nomination is then deemed to have been paid for the latest filing if the two nominations are for the same jurisdiction (except in the case where a person files for a nomination for the office of Mayor, in which case an additional \$100.00 may be required).

On or before 4 pm Monday September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 the Clerk will examine each nomination filed and, if satisfied that the person is qualified to be nominated and that the nomination complies with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 as amended, the Clerk will certify the nomination. If not satisfied, the Clerk will reject the nomination and, as soon as possible, give notice to the person

who sought to be nominated and to all other candidates for that office. The Clerk's decision to certify or reject a nomination is final.

Where there are more certified candidates than are required to fill the office, notice will be given of the locations of voting places, the dates and times that voting places will be open for voting, the manner in which electors may use voting proxies, and any alternative voting methods.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that where, at 4 p.m. on **Monday September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010**, the number of certified candidates for an office is the same as or less than the number to be elected, the clerk shall immediately declare the candidate or candidates elected by acclamation. **On Wednesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010**, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2 p.m., additional nominations may be filed for the remaining vacancies in the office in respect of which there was an insufficient number of certified candidates, and the provisions of subsection 33 (5) and 37 (2) apply.
